



RIDING VIDEO RETEST PROCEDURES FOR LEVEL 1 CANDIDATES ONLY

Level 1 Riding Retests have the options to return for the second day of the Level 1 course to ride for the day with the group while being assessed by the PMBIA Course Conductor. Or you can submit a video of your riding for review.

HOW TO MAKE A RIDING RETEST VIDEO

1. Your riding retest video should be between 3-6 minutes long, with good quality HD footage (no shaky portrait phone shots) and must be **uploaded to Youtube** (this typically requires a free YouTube account that is quick and easy to set up). *No other format, including emailed mp4's or videos, will be accepted.*
2. Video must include multiple shots of cornering, descending and climbing on technical, blue single-track terrain, so the Course Conductor can assess the 'Six Skills' - Position & Balance, Operation of Controls, Terrain Awareness, Direction Control, Pressure Control and Timing & Coordination.
3. Video must show front, rear and pedalling wheel lifts over a stick, slow tight turns and a roll down.
4. **Video link must be submitted to info@pmbia.org.**
5. Video riding re-tests will be charged \$95 + tax

Please allow up to 14 working days for a video review and for new results and Candidate Evaluation Form, to be issued.
